Fundamentals of Quilting

Supply List

For first session please bring to class the following:

- Basic sewing supplies-
pincushion
straight pins, 0.05mm shaft, 1 1/4" long, preferably without large heads
seam ripper
- Sewing machine in good repair
- Rotary cutting equipment
6"x24" ruler (Omnigrid work well)
23"x35" mat (Olfa is a good brand)
rotary cutter
- Fabrics
1 yard for border and parts of blocks (1 1/4 yd. for optional size)
3/4 yd. for background (1 yd. for optional size)
1 1/4 yd. for back
6 to 8 1/4 yd. pieces of coordinating fabrics
1/2 yd. for binding (a good choice is one of the fabrics already chosen for the quilt top)
- Thread to blend with fabric

One method of fabric selection is to choose a main fabric that has at least three colors and coordinate the other fabrics to the main fabric. Try for a selection of light, medium and dark colors; a variety of pattern scale (size); and a variety of textures in the prints. Fabric choices will be reviewed in class and if you prefer to wait to complete selections just bring three or four fabrics you like to the first session.

Other supplies will be discussed at the first class session.
